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## Food for Thought for the week of June 9, 2024

study questions with your personal devotions!\*\*

1) This week we read in James 2:13 how "judgment is without mercy to the one who has shown no mercy." Look up and read Matthew 18:21-35. What stands out to you from this passage?

What things make it harder for you to forgive others?

Why do you think Jesus makes such a big deal about not forgiving those who sin against us?

Sometimes we need to stop and remember our own sin against God, so that we can remember the immense "debt" that He has forgiven us of. Doing so will help us to forgive others when they sin against us.

**2)** Explain in your own words how the following statements relate to each other:

**Ephesians 2:8-9** - "[8] For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, [9] not of works, lest anyone should boast."

**James 2:17** - "Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead."

If someone told you they don't think they could ever make it to heaven, what would you tell them?

If someone told you they're headed for heaven because they believe in Jesus - yet their life lacks any fruit - what would you tell them?

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3) Looking back at your walk with Jesus, what are some specific things He has changed in your heart? What are some ways you are different now that you believe in Jesus?

What are some specific things you can do this week to *SHOW* your faith?

4) What stands out to you in the following passage?

Luke 6:46-49 - "[46] "But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,'

dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when the
flood arose, the stream beat vehemently against that house,

"But he who heard and did nothing is like a man who built a
house on the earth without a foundation, against which the
stream beat vehemently; and immediately it fell. And the ruin
of that house was great.""

What can you do when you feel stuck between God's command to obey and your sinful heart that doesn't want to?
