[#1] In Chapter 4, James is reminding these Jewish followers of Jesus ... Their "Old Sin Nature" is at **WAR** with God!

(Gal. 5:16-25; 2 Cor. 5:21; Rom. 6:11; Gal. 2:20)

[#2] Jesus went to the cross to set them and us free from the **PENALTY** and **POWER** of the 'Old Sin Nature' in our lives.

[#3] Three R's of "Walking in the Spirit"...

1st R – **RECOGNIZE** you're in a spiritual Battle . . .

2nd R – **RECKON** the 'Old Sin Nature' as Dead, Crucified with Christ (Rom. 6:11) . . .

3rd R – **REJOICE** in the new life in the Spirit that Jesus gives . . .

(1 Jn 4:4; 1 Pet. 5:6-7; James 2:12-13; Gal. 5:13-16)

[#4] The Acts of the 'Old Sin Nature' manifests itself through you in **PRIDE** and **JUDGEMENT** . . .

The Fruit of the 'Spirit' manifests new life through you in **HUMILITY**, **MERCY** and **LOVE** . . .

(1 Jn 4:4; Luke 12:16-21)

[#5] The most foolish thing a person can do is to Not **CRUCIFY** his/her 'Old Sin Nature'!

(Mark 8:36; John 7:37-39)
